Opći cilj projekta SOUNDSCAPE je procjena utjecaja podvodne buke na morsku faunu i ekosustav Sjevernog Jadrana te stvoriti mrežu prekograničnog nadzora koji čini tehnička, znanstvena i institucionalna suradnja, a sve kako bi se osigurala učinkovita zaštita morske biološke raznolikosti i održivo korištenje morskog i obalnog ekosustava i resursa.

Sjeverni Jadran je područje pod velikim utjecajem sve intenzivnijeg i rastućeg pomorskog prometa, turizma kao i eksploatacije prirodnih resursa, dok ujedno ima vrlo ugroženu biološku raznolikost. Većina regije smatra se ekološki i biološki značajnim područjem (EBSA, Konvencija o biološkoj raznolikosti), kao i mreža Natura 2000, odnosno, ekološka mreža zaštićenih područja na području Europske unije (najveća koordinirana mreža područja očuvanja prirode u svijetu), te mjesto morskih i obalnih zaštićenih područja (MPAs).

Podizanje javne svijesti o utjecaju podvodne buke na morski okoliš i važnost očuvanja prirodnog bogatstva jedan od glavnih pitanja projekta, s obzirom da postoji vrlo ograničeno znanje o ovoj temi u javnosti.

The overall objective of the SOUNDSCAPE project is to assess the impact of underwater environmental noise on the marine fauna and in general on the ecosystem of the Northern Adriatic Sea and to create a cross-border monitoring net supported by technical, scientific and institutional cooperation in order to ensure an efficient protection of marine biodiversity and to develop a sustainable use of marine and coastal ecosystems and resources.

The Northern Adriatic Sea (NAS) is an area highly impacted by increasing maritime traffic, tourism and resource exploitation, whilst having a very vulnerable biodiversity. Most of the region is considered to be an Ecologically and Biologically Significant Area (EBSA, Convention on Biological Diversity), as well as hosting varied Natura 2000 sites and marine and coastal protected areas (MPAs).

The raising of public awareness of the impact of underwater noise for the environments one of the main issues of the project, given that there is a very limited knowledge about this topic among the general public.
